

Converting Olex plotter data to Google Earth format.


1 Install Perl software



- Download ActivePerl from www.activestate.com
- Install - keep defaults - will associate with .pl files

2 Export Olex data

- Either export all plotter data:
[Settings]> [Save data to storage device] > [All plotter data] or...
- Create a selection with a polygon:
[Alt+left mouse button]>[Area].



- To select a subset of objects [Line or symbol] you will then be able to select specific symbols or lines.
Save to storage device with default name "olexplot.gz"

- Select all features using [Objects] then [Export these objects] or...



3 Convert and open

- Download and unzip Olex2GoogleEarth.zip :

Place olexplot.gz file inside the folder (overwrite existing file).
The file Olex2KML2.pl should be associated with the ActivePerl program. ■ Double-clicking on the Olex2KML2.pl file will run the script and produce files called "olexplot" and "Olex_Plot_Convert_YYYY_MM_DD_HR.kml"
this file can be opened by Google Earth.



- To share the file: In Google Earth go to [File]>[Save as] and select .kmz extension.
